Notice Regarding State Compliance December 22, 2009

States that are going to be unable to comply with all NMVTIS requirements by January 1, 2010, are strongly encouraged to submit a NMVTIS implementation plan to DOJ before January 1, 2010. This implementation plan should include the following: 1) a brief explanation of the reason the state is unable to meet the compliance deadline; and 2) a timeline that is being followed to bring the state into compliance with its <u>obligations</u> under federal <u>law</u> and <u>regulation</u> to report data and verify titles, including the dates by which full compliance will be achieved. Implementation plans should be submitted to NMVTIS@usdoj.gov.

DOJ continues to work collaboratively with each state to ensure full compliance and will consider all options to address non-compliance. Since 1997, DOJ has invested more than \$22 million in federal funding for the operation and implementation of NMVTIS. Based on the availability of funds, DOJ will continue to explore future funding opportunities to assist states.

The system operator, American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA), is responsible for developing resources, tools, and materials to help states with NMVTIS implementation.
